Muhammad Mubaraki, BSc, MSc, Dip(BA), PhD, Fellow ASCE, Editor



Dr. Mubaraki is a Saudi Arabian national; he earned his BSc. in Civil Engineering (January 1994) from King Fahad University of Petroleum and Minerals (KFUPM), and his MSc. in Civil Engineering (Transportation) in (January 2004) from King Saud University (KSU), and obtained his PhD in Civil Engineering (Transportation) from University of Nottingham, UK in (March 2010). He got a diploma in business administration (BA) from Riyadh Chamber of Commerce and Industry (June 2006).

Dr. Mubaraki is an associate professor of Civil Engineering in Jazan University, Jazan, Saudi Arabia, fellow ASCE since 2012, editor since 2012, and a visiting scholar at University of Oklahoma. He is currently the acting dean of Baish Community College (December 2016-Present). His research interest in pavement engineering, pavement management systems, asset management, mathematical and statistical modeling of infrastructures. He served at Jazan University, as an assistant professor (May 2011-December 2015), the Chairman of the Department of Civil Engineering (March 2014 – May 2016), and the general supervisor of projects (December 2011-November 2016), Also, he served as the director of training unit (July 2011-June 2013), and the coordinator of international collaboration (August 2013- August 2014) for college of engineering. Member of board of Saudi Society for Traffic Safety (SALAMH) (December 2012- June 2016). He served in 14 standing committees (academic and technical) at/out Jazan University (December 2011- September 2016). He is an associate member and member of 12 professional societies and institutions in civil engineering, and related areas (May 2006 - present). He is serving as an editor and reviewer for 13 international journals since March 2010. He participated for many conferences as session's chair, member of scientific committees, keynote speaker, and presenter. Moreover, he is serving as international member for 3 committees for Transportation Research Board (TRB) in US since 2011.

Dr. Mubaraki has authored/coauthored a total of (47) refereed publications of which 24 are fully refereed journal publications, and 23 refereed conference publications. He has been invited for (25) presentations including; keynote speaker in North America, Europe, and Middle East, in the areas of concrete technology and rehabilitation, pavement engineering, pavement maintenance and rehabilitation, pavement management system, asset management, and quality in education. Dr. Mubaraki supervises two PhD students at the National University of Malaysia (Department of Civil and Structural Engineering) as a Co-Supervisor.
